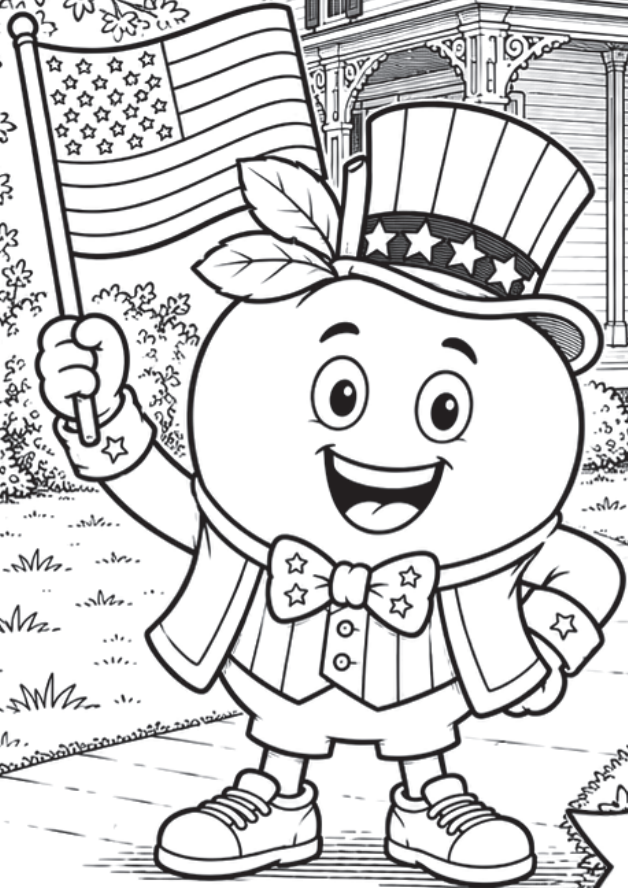
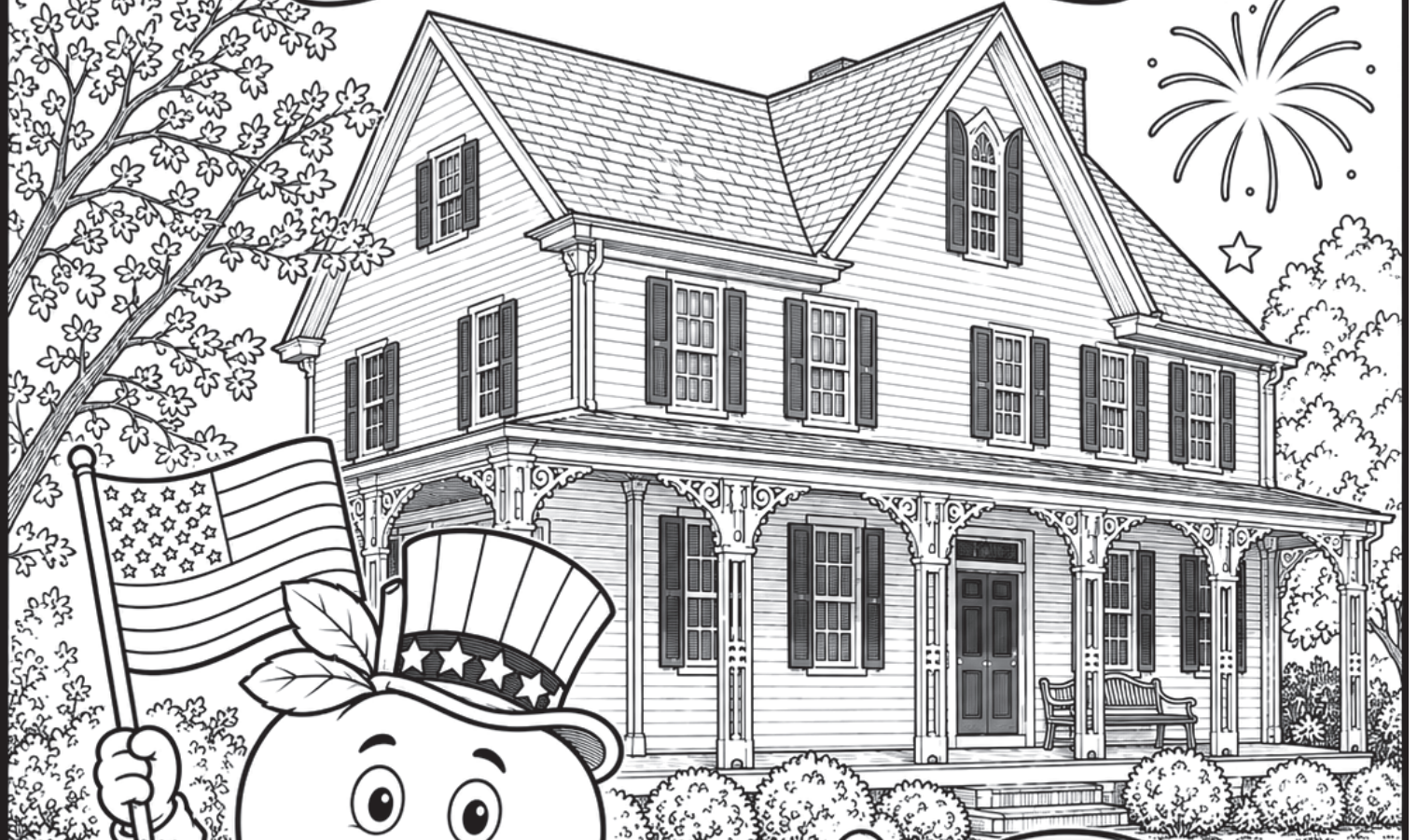

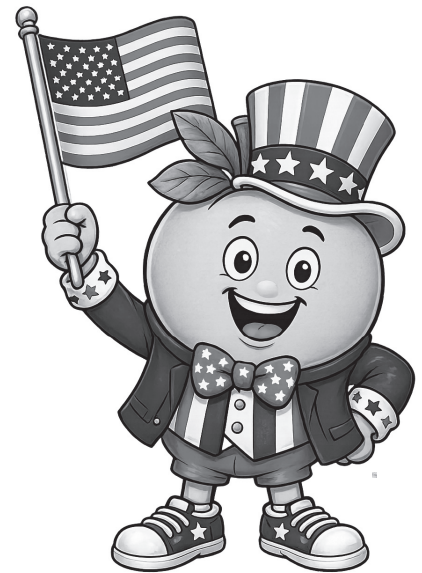

## John Inskeep House

More than 250 years ago, in about 1771, part of this house was built here in Evesham. It later became the home of John Inskeep, an early resident connected to the growing village that would become Marlton.

Over the years, the house changed and grew, just like Evesham did. Today, the John Inskeep House is cared for by the Evesham Historical Society so families can learn about what life was like long ago.
